Suzanne Ward, an Honors US History of Government and Economics teacher at Ridge High School, discussed Project Citizen and described it as a year-long curricular program sponsored by the Center for Civic Education that is designed to promote competent and responsible participation with government at all levels. The program helps participants learn how to monitor and influence public policy while developing support for democratic values and principles, tolerance, and feelings of political efficacy.

As a result of Project Citizen, Honors Government & Economics students have had the opportunity to investigate a problem that impacts their daily lives. Through their research and collaboration with the various stakeholders involved, the students analyzed how the problem could best be addressed and developed an action plan to make their policy ideas a reality. Project Citizen prepares students to be active citizens outside of the classroom by fueling their commitment to be involved and by providing the skills that they will need to do so.

Six students, Abhay Badala, Gillian Begg, Arohi Dandawate, Sam Lewis, Alex Petric, Owen Rhatican and Jack Vorsheim, created a presentation that focused on Recycling at Ridge High School. The students took turns providing detailed information regarding the process, problems, potential solutions to the problems and the final solution they agreed would create the impact desired.
