Regardless of whether you use method 1, 2 or 3 for public comment please note that:

- Public comments are limited to a maximum of approximately 3 minutes if read aloud.
- Individuals are permitted a maximum of one public comment during public comment on agenda items. Individuals are permitted a maximum of one public comment during public comment on non-agenda items.

- Public comments submitted via method 1 and 2 will be processed first, then comments submitted by method 3. An individual's comments made using method 1 or 2 will not also be read into the record through method 3.
- The Board of Education reserves the right to limit the length of time allotted for public comment (for both agenda items and non-agenda items). In the event that time limitations prohibit the reading of a public comment received pursuant to these instructions, the comment will be published as part of the meeting minutes.
- No public comments will be accepted before 7PM or after item XIX. Board Forum of the agenda begins.

Resolution

VII. Student Representative - Juliet Nolt

Ms. Nolt provided an update with regard to the return to a full five-day schedule for students and the adjustments and the Ridge High School Drama Club and the upcoming presentation of *Cats*.

VIII. Public Hearing 2021-22 Budget

1) 2021-22 School Budget Presentation – Rod McLaughlin, Business Administrator/Board Secretary and Nick Markarian, Superintendent

Business Administrator McLaughlin presented the financial aspect of the district's proposed budget for the 2021-22 school year. Mr. McLaughlin detailed the anticipated revenue and expenditures, debt expense changes and the budgeted fund balance. Mr. McLaughlin discussed major factors in the budget noting programs are sustained and some factors that negatively impacted the budget including Chapter 44 Health Benefit programs and the unionization of facilities services.

Business Administrator McLaughlin discussed sustaining programs and services noting that the budget sustains the district goals. Mr. McLaughlin also discussed expanded opportunities, enrollment decline and provided a history of per-pupil spending in the classroom.

Business Administrator McLaughlin provided further detail into the impact on the budget of the state mandated Chapter 44 Health Benefit programs that was signed into law on July 1, 2020, district employee enrollment numbers in those health benefit programs and the impact on the budget. Mr. McLaughlin also provided further detail of the impact of unionization of facilities contracts for custodial, grounds and maintenance and the resulting escalation of wages and health benefit plans.

Business Administrator McLaughlin discussed state aid and costs associated with the public health emergency. Mr. McLaughlin also detailed federal funds including ESSER II funds designed to assist during the public health emergency.

Business Administrator McLaughlin discussed the 11 year tax history and current net taxpayer impact and upcoming capital projects for the district detailing the renovation of the William Annin Science Labs.

Superintendent Markarian thanked Business Administrator McLaughlin for his hard work. Mr. Markarian discussed staffing considerations, enrollment numbers, changes in staff, summer 2021 instructional programs and staffing realignments for fall of 2021.
