Also as a matter of law, a Board of Education may only vote for or against the hiring of an employee upon the recommendation of the superintendent. If the superintendent does not recommend a person, that person's name is not listed on the agenda and there is no vote on that action.

If it is necessary for the Board to go into executive session at the end of the meeting, we will provide an estimated length of time for the session and whether any action is anticipated to be taken upon returning to public session.

IX. Board Presentation

- 1) **Interventionist/Title I Update** - Lisa Vitale-Stanzione, Supervisor of Special Education

Ms. Vitale-Stanzione, the Supervisor of Special Education presented the Bernards Township School District with an update on her work as the K-5 Interventionist and how she is using the Title I Funds received by the District.

Highlights included:

- A breakdown of days spent at all district elementary schools performing evaluations for students who may need early intervention services
- Core Principles of Response to Intervention (RTI) and New Jersey Tiered System of Support (NJTSS) including:
 - Assessment for screening-diagnostic-progress monitoring
 - Multi-tier model of service delivery
 - Implement interventions & instruction
 - Monitoring of student progress
- Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy (DIBELS) training and implementation
- DIBELS data and results
- Future goals including What I Need (WIN) groups, follow ups, curriculum review and implementation for the 2017-18 School Year

Board members asked questions regarding the process and timing and the impact of early intervention on the special education students in the district.
