WHEREAS, the Bernards Township Board of Education believes the supplementation of its capital reserve is consistent with efficient and effective management of district facilities and financial resources; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Bernards Township Board of Education hereby authorizes the supplementation of its capital reserve fund with a transfer not to exceed \$2,850,000 pursuant to the authority under N.J.S.A 18A:7F-41(6)(a) and NJAC 6A:23A-14.3(a).
