The bus will drop off at the St. James Theater, located at 246 West 44th Street, between Broadway and 8th Avenue, at approximately 11:30 AM. Lunch is on your own. Show time is 2:00 PM. Show run time is 2 hours & 30 minutes, including one intermission. Bus will depart NYC immediately following the show.

About the Tickets: Tickets are \$110 per person – includes Center Front MEZZANINE seating, rows C, D, E & F and motor coach transportation. Non-refundable once paid. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

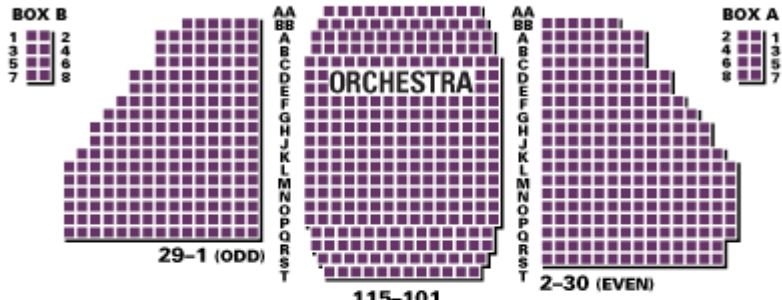

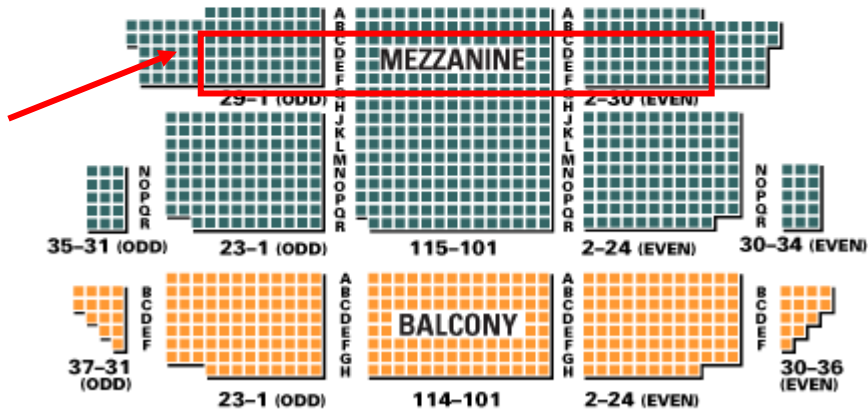

- **HANDICAP ACCESS** - The St James Theatre is not completely wheelchair accessible. There are no steps into the theatre. Please be advised that where there are steps either into or within the theatre, we are unable to provide assistance. There are no elevators or escalators.
- **SEATING** - Mezzanine seating is located on the 2nd level up 29 steps. There is an additional 49 steps up to the remainder of the Mezzanine. Entrance to Mezzanine is behind row E.
- **RESTROOM** - Wheelchair accessible restrooms (unisex) located on the main level. Ladies' restroom located on the Lower level, Mezzanine and Balcony levels. Men's restroom located on the Lower level and Balcony.
