5) The Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby approve renewal #1 of a contract with **ARAMARK Corporation** to provide custodial, maintenance and grounds services for the 2006-07 school year at a cost of \$4,150,957. This represents a 4% increase over from the 2005-06 school year.

6) The Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby approve a contract renewal #1 with **Waste Management of New Jersey, Inc.** of Plainfield, NJ to provide waste collection services for the 2006-07 school year at an annual fee of \$56,556.

7) WHEREAS, the registered voters of Bernards Township approved the proposal to raise \$61,313,765 in the general funds for the 2006-07 school year at the Annual School Election held on April 18, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the registered voters of Bernards Township defeated the additional spending question in the amount of \$253,000 for General Funds in the 2006-07 school year; the taxes being used exclusively for restoration of the full time elementary enrichment program, the addition of one new teacher at Ridge High School, and the restoration of the middle school assistant principal; and

WHEREAS, the Bernards Township Board of Education was required by law to submit documentation to the municipal governing body on the defeated spending question for a determination of the amount, if any, that should be certified as part of the overall general fund tax levy; and,

WHEREAS, a meeting was held between elected officials and staff of the municipality and the Board of Education on May 17, 2006 to discuss the additional \$253,000 General Fund Budget during which changes to the budget were reviewed; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Bernards certified the tax levy for the additional \$253,000 for General Fund Tax Levy of the 2006-07 Bernards Township Board of Education Budget in the amount of \$0; and

WHEREAS, the additional spending question cannot be restored by the New Jersey Department of Education;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Bernards Township Board of Education acknowledges the Determination and Certification of the Additional Spending Proposal for the 2006-07 school year adopted by the Bernards Township Committee on May 17, 2006 in its resolution #060268.
