BE IT RESOLVED that the Bernards Township Board of Education met in closed session to discuss: matters pertaining to specific personnel; negotiations; and further

BE IT RESOLVED that the matters discussed in closed session will be disclosed to the public as soon as and to the extent that such disclosure can be made without adversely affecting the public interest or without violation of the confidentiality of personnel.

On motion by Mr. Byrne, seconded by Mr. Carlucci, and approved by all present, the Board recessed into closed executive session at 5:05 p.m.

On motion by Ms. Cwerner, seconded by Ms. Carlsson, and approved by all present, the Board returned to public session at 6:30 p.m. to be available to meet with representatives of the Ridge Student Government. No students attended.

The Board reconvened the regular meeting in the Cedar Hill School Multi-Purpose Room at 7:00 p.m.

IV. Regular Session – Call to Order – 7:00 p.m. – Board of Education Conference Room

V. **Statement of Public Notice**

This was a regular meeting of the Board of Education of Bernards Township. Notice of the time and place of this meeting was provided and copies of that resolution were forwarded to the official newspapers as designated by the Board of Education and to the Township Clerk and a copy of the notice was posted on the bulletin board of the Board of Education Offices in accordance with P.L. 1975 Chapter 231A.

We very much welcome input from the public. There are two times during regular meetings that the public is invited to speak. One time is early in the meeting before the Board votes, and you may speak about any item that is listed on tonight's agenda. Towards the end of the meeting, there is another public forum to address any topic whatsoever.

When you approach the microphone, please state your name and address. We do not have a specific time limit, but we ask that you keep your comments brief. Please understand that our public forums are not structured as question and answer sessions, but rather they are offered as opportunities to share your thoughts with the Board. In instances where the Board feels that there is a misunderstanding or inaccuracy, a member of the Board or Administration will address it in the Board Response portion of the agenda.

There are times when a member of the public makes a comment or asks a question about an employee. New Jersey statute does not permit us to discuss personnel issues in public. Also as a matter of law, a Board of Education may only vote for or against the hiring of an employee upon the recommendation of the superintendent. If the superintendent does not recommend a person, that person's name is not listed on the agenda and there is no vote on that action. If it is necessary for the Board to go into executive session at the end of the meeting, we will provide an estimated length of time for the session and whether any action is anticipated to be taken upon returning to public session.

VI. **Board Presentation**

1) Director of Special Services Monica Butler introduced a presentation regarding the results of **American Alcohol & Drug Survey (ADAS)**. Assisting Ms. Butler was Ms. Forgione of the Bernards Township Health Department, Dr. Bush, Mr. Gillikin and Ms. Hoffman SAC (Bernards Township Student Assistance Counselors). The presentation touched on:

- Community goals
- Overview of the Municipal Alliance
- Fundraising and disbursement of grants
- Identification of alcohol, tobacco and drug use among students
- Review of previously conducted surveys

- Explanation and results of the current ADAS survey
- Preventative and intervention activities
- Current programs being conducted at all three grade levels

Following the presentation Ms. Butler spoke on a year-long survey being conducted through Rutgers University. Bernards Township is one of eight districts selected to participate with results being available at the close of the 2009-10 school year. Ms. Butler also explained the proposed changes in Policy File Code: 5530 Substance Use/Pupils that are being mandated by the state.

VII. Public Forum on Agenda Items

Comments were made regarding the ADAS survey and its results, alternative methods of educating students and the random drug testing program. An additional comment was made regarding transfer of funds.

VIII. Board Response

An explanation of the procedure and law involved with suspension-based drug testing was given, the status of extracurricular activity revenue cuts for the 2009-10 school year and the necessity to transfer funds to meet budgetary shortfalls.

Board comments on the ADAS presentation included the process for suspension-based drug testing and alerting the police, notification to students of the status of extracurricular activities available for the 2009-10 school year, obtaining additional information regarding student alcohol and drug involvement, and the addition of programs.
