If the superintendent does not recommend a person, that person's name is not listed on the agenda and there is no vote on that action. If it is necessary for the Board to go into executive session at the end of the meeting, we will provide an estimated length of time for the session and whether any action is anticipated to be taken upon returning to public session.

Chairperson Robin McKeon updated the Board on the recent Curriculum Committee meeting highlighting an update regarding college admission data (a complete report will be presented in the fall), a review of textbooks for Board adoption, the high school summer reading program, availability of math resources online, and changes to the math curriculum at the middle school due to the implementation of the Common Core Standards. Ms. McKeon updated the options discussed to address concerns related to compliance with State Law for gifted and talented. The committee is recommending summer curriculum writing and will continue to review assessment options, and the identification/notification process. Ms. Kusel thanked the committee for its quick response to the concerns raised by parents in regard to this program.

XII. Public Forum on Other Than Agenda Items

Other comments included reviews of research studies on gifted education, the clustering method of teaching, meeting the needs of the gifted and talented child, the current differentiated instruction method of providing additional services to this group of students, homogenous grouping, careful consideration when making changes that impact all students, and the access route through the Health Department in regard to the entrance at Ridge High School.

XIII. Board Forum

Comments were made regarding development of a selection process for gifted and talented students. Superintendent Markarian updated the Board on the response from the county engineer regarding the access road at the high school. Plans were submitted and reviewed at the county level. The county concern is in regard to the impact to the South Finley Avenue traffic pattern. The township engineer indicated that additional survey work needed to be done in order to take the next step in the design and engineering of the proposed driveway. Mr. Markarian stated that if the Board agrees, a formal resolution authorizing the firm of Hatch Mott MacDonald to proceed would be necessary.

BE IT RESOLVED THAT

1) The Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby authorize **Hatch Mott MacDonald** to perform additional survey work necessary to continue the engineering and design of a new driveway to connect Ridge High School to South Finley Avenue in an amount not to exceed \$5,000.
