BE IT RESOLVED THAT

- 1) The Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby approve the following resolution concerning a lease-purchase financing with a projected maximum funding level of \$1,250,000.

WHEREAS, The Board of Education of the Township of Bernards in the County of Somerset, New Jersey (the "Board" when referring to the governing body and the "School District" when referring to the territorial boundaries governed by the Board), is considering a capital improvement project, consisting of repointing and roof and sidewalk replacement at Oak Street School, boiler and front entrance replacement at Liberty Corner School, boiler replacement at William Annin Middle School, bathroom renovation at Cedar Hill School and replacement of hallway lockers at Ridge High School (the "Project") at an approximate cost of \$2,000,000; and

WHEREAS, the Board is considering funding the estimated local share of the Project through a lease-purchase financing with a projected maximum funding level of \$1,250,000, as authorized pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:20-4.2(f); and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to establish a date for the statutorily required public hearing on the Project and to provide for the corresponding publication of a notice of such public hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by The Board of Education of the Township of Bernards in the County of Somerset, New Jersey, as follows:

1. A public hearing on the Project and the proposed \$1,250,000 lease-purchase financing to fund same shall be held on Monday, May 19, 2003 at the Cedar Hill School cafeteria at 8 p.m.

2. Bond Counsel is hereby authorized and directed, nunc pro tunc in accordance with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 18A:20-4.2(f), to publicly advertise the attached Notice of Public Hearing concerning the Project in the Bernardsville News.

3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

New Jersey School Boards Association

1) The Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby adopt the following resolution in regard to State Aid Funding:

WHEREAS, New Jersey school boards have an obligation to provide all students a thorough and efficient education; and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Educational Improvement and Financing ACT (CEIFA) of 1996 established for the first time a substantive definition of the constitutional guarantee of a thorough and efficient system of education through the establishment of Core Curriculum Standards; and

WHEREAS, CEIFA guarantees an appropriate level of funding to ensure that each child has the opportunity to achieve the Core Curriculum Content Standards; and

WHEREAS, freezing state aid for the 2002-03 fiscal year contradicted CEIFA and the spirit of the state mandate/state pay amendment to the state Constitution; and

WHEREAS, flat funding forced many school districts to lay off teachers and support personnel and basic skills and enrichment programs, eliminate extracurricular and athletic activities, and/or increase class sizes to compensate for the State’s failure to provide sufficient aid; and

WHEREAS, even after making cuts, hundreds of school districts still had to raise taxes to deal with rising enrollments and fixed costs that are beyond their control, such as health and insurance benefits, out-of-district special education placements, and utility bills; and

WHEREAS, more than a third of all school budgets were defeated by the voters last year, the largest rejection rate since 1994; and

WHEREAS, thousands of homeowners wound up paying hundreds of dollars more in property taxes, which surged an average of 7 percent, the biggest one-year jump since 1990; and

WHEREAS, any decision to freeze state aid during the 2003-04 fiscal year or to only provide an increase that matches the Consumer Price Index (CPI) would be calamitous for public schools students, property taxpayers and local boards of education, which have already seen their expenses exceed the CPI; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Bernards Township Board of Education urges Governor James E. McGreevey and the state Legislature to fully fund CEIFA so that school districts have resources they need to provide their students a thorough and efficient education, which is protected by the state Constitution; and be it further

RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Governor, all legislators representing the 16th district, and to the New Jersey School Board Association.
