On motion by Ms. Cwerner, seconded by Ms Kusel, and approved by all present, the Board recessed into closed executive session at 6:30 p.m.

On motion by Ms. Kusel, seconded by Ms. Cwerner, and approved by all present, the Board returned to public session at 6:55 p.m.

The Board reconvened the regular meeting in the William Annin Middle School Auditorium at 7:00 p.m.

VI. Regular Session – Call to Order – 7:00 p.m. – William Annin Middle School Auditorium

VII. Statement of Public Notice

This was a regular Meeting of the Board of Education of Bernards Township. Notice of the time and place of this meeting was provided and copies of that resolution were forwarded to the official newspapers as designated by the Board of Education and to the Township Clerk and a copy of the notice was posted on the bulletin board of the Board of Education Offices in accordance with P.L. 1975 Chapter 231A.

We very much welcome input from the public. There are two times during regular meetings that the public is invited to speak. One time is early in the meeting before the Board votes, and you may speak about any item that is listed on tonight's agenda. Towards the end of the meeting, there is another public forum to address any topic whatsoever.

When you approach the microphone, please state your name and address. We do not have a specific time limit, but we ask that you keep your comments brief. Please understand that our public forums are not structured as question and answer sessions, but rather they are offered as opportunities to share your thoughts with the Board. Any Board responses to public comment will be addressed during Board Forum, or during committee reports.

There are times when a member of the public makes a comment or asks a question about an employee. New Jersey statute does not permit us to discuss personnel issues in public. Also as a matter of law, a Board of Education may only vote for or against the hiring of an employee upon the recommendation of the superintendent. If the superintendent does not recommend a person, that person's name is not listed on the agenda and there is no vote on that action. If it is necessary for the Board to go into executive session at the end of the meeting, we will provide an estimated length of time for the session and whether any action is anticipated to be taken upon returning to public session.

VIII. Student Representative

Student Representative Ellexa Thomas reported on fundraising activities at the high school including the Sophomore's canned food drive, the upcoming Junior/Senior volleyball tournament, and the annual Teddy Bear decorating project with donations being delivered to local hospitals and charities. On January 8, 2014, Ridge High School

students, along with students from around the state, will participate in the TCNJ Leadership Conference.

IX. Board Presentation

- 1) Ridge High School Driveway Update – Nick Markarian Superintendent of Schools & Frank Howlett Principal Ridge High School

Superintendent Nick Markarian presented an update of the proposed construction of a new access/egress road to primarily relieve morning drop off traffic issues at the high school. The change would bring student bus drop off back on the campus and at the same time separate parent drop off and bus traffic. Buses would utilize the new two-way road adjacent to the Health Dept. for both access/egress. Only car traffic would use the oval.

Questions from the Board included the afternoon traffic flow and pattern, impact of loss of parking spaces due to revised configuration, impact on the Health Dept., and the next steps in the process to enable work to begin next summer. Utilizing this plan means there will be no expansion of South Finley Avenue nor reclaiming of property along that street.

X. Superintendent's Report

BE IT RESOLVED THAT

- 1) The Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby direct the Superintendent of Schools and the Business Administrator to seek bids for the purpose of constructing a new Ridge High School driveway access to be installed in the summer of 2014.
- 2) The Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby adopt the following resolution for submission to New Jersey Department of Education:

WHEREAS, 18A:7a-10 establishes the New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (NJQSAC) for evaluating performance of each school district, and

WHEREAS, the evaluation of the district is based upon five key components of school district effectiveness: instruction and program, personnel, fiscal management, operations, and governance, and

WHEREAS, Bernards Township School District's five components were reviewed by the New Jersey Department of Education in the 2012-13 school year, and received the maximum designation as 'High Performing School District', and

WHEREAS, Bernards Township School District is not scheduled to undergo QSAC this year, and all districts not undergoing QSAC in any particular school year must complete a Statement of Assurance (SOA) annually, and

WHEREAS, Bernards Township School District assures that all indicators in the QSAC review have continued to be met,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby approve the submission to the New Jersey Department of Education of the Statement of Assurance (on file at the Bernards Township Board of Education office) as certified by the Chief School Administrator and Board President.

Mr. Markarian expressed his appreciation to Mr. Koch for his eleven years of service to both the school district, students, and the community. Mr. Markarian also recognized that today was Veteran’s Day and he thanked our veterans.

Comments made regarding the proposed access/egress road at the high school with consideration being given to the intersection at South Finley and Lake Road, the potential utilization of the Health Dept. road as a means for traffic to make a left turn from that egress, the timeframe for a final construction plan, and receipt of approvals from state and local agencies. In addition, a request was made for the Comprehensive Maintenance Plan to be made available to the public.
