WHEREAS the **Liberty Corner School roof** has deteriorated to such a point as to effect the health, safety, and well-being of the students, and

WHEREAS a careful and thorough inspection and evaluation of the roof have indicated that a complete replacement is necessary, and

WHEREAS the roof replacement project is part of the district's Long Range Facility Plan, and

WHEREAS the architect, Thomas Rienzi, has estimated the cost for this project is \$337,124.00, and

WHEREAS the roof project must be completed during a non-occupied time during the summer,

THEREFORE, let it be resolved that the Bernards Township Board of Education approves the project of the replacement roof at Liberty Corner School and, furthermore, submits plans and specifications to the Department of Education, Division of Facility and Transportation.

5) The Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby approve the following resolution in regard to the Cedar Hill School unit ventilator lines:

WHEREAS the **Cedar Hill School supply and return to the unit ventilator lines** have deteriorated to such a point as to effect the health, safety, and well-being of the students, and

WHEREAS a careful and thorough inspection and evaluation of the supply and return to the unit ventilator lines has indicated that a complete replacement is necessary, and

WHEREAS the supply and return to the unit ventilator lines replacement project is part of the district's Long Range Facility Plan, and

WHEREAS the estimated cost for this project is \$285,000.00, and

WHEREAS the supply and return to the unit ventilator lines project must be completed during a non-occupied time during the summer,

THEREFORE, let it be resolved that the Bernards Township Board of Education approves the replacement project of the supply and return to the unit ventilator lines at Cedar Hill School and, furthermore, submits plans and specifications to the Department of Education, Division of Facility and Transportation.

6) The Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby approve the following resolution in regard to the Cedar Hill School fire panel:

WHEREAS the **Cedar Hill School fire panel** has deteriorated to such a point as to effect the health, safety, and well-being of the students, and

WHEREAS a careful and thorough inspection and evaluation of the fire panel has indicated that a complete replacement is necessary, and

WHEREAS the fire panel replacement project is part of the district's Long Range Facility Plan, and

WHEREAS the estimated cost for this project is \$6,800.00, and

WHEREAS the fire panel must be completed during a non-occupied time during the summer,

THEREFORE, let it be resolved that the Bernards Township Board of Education approves the project of the replacement fire panel at Cedar Hill School and, furthermore, submits plans and specifications to the Department of Education, Division of Facility and Transportation.

7) The Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby approve the following resolution in regard to the Ridge High School auditorium sound system:

WHEREAS the **Ridge High School auditorium sound system** has deteriorated to such a point as to effect the safety and well-being of the students, and

WHEREAS a careful and thorough inspection and evaluation of the Ridge High School auditorium sound system has indicated that a complete replacement is necessary, and

WHEREAS the Ridge High School auditorium sound system replacement project is part of the district's Long Range Facility Plan, and

WHEREAS the estimated cost for this project is \$55,000.00, and

WHEREAS the Ridge High School auditorium sound system must be completed during a non-occupied time during the summer,

THEREFORE, let it be resolved that the Bernards Township Board of Education approves the replacement project of the Ridge High School auditorium sound system and, furthermore, submits plans and specifications to the Department of Education, Division of Facility and Transportation.

8) The Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby approve a contract with **Asbury Park Technology Center** to provide budget accounting software and support for the 2002-03 school year at a cost of \$24,155.

NEW JERSEY SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATION

BE IT RESOLVED THAT

1) The Bernards Township Board of Education does hereby adopt the following resolution which would legalize the use of project labor agreements in New Jersey:

WHEREAS, New Jersey’s school boards are already under tremendous pressure to reduce costs and keep a lid on rising property taxes; and

WHEREAS, S-1044/A-1926 would legalize the use of project labor agreements in New Jersey and authorize any public entity that undertakes a public works project to enter into a project labor agreement with one or more labor organizations; and

WHEREAS, S-1044/A-1926 would result in restricted competition and higher costs at the expense of school districts and local taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, the current system of awarding bids in open competition to the lowest responsible bidder has proven both effective and cost worthy;

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law has been consistently upheld by the New Jersey Supreme Court to be in the best interests of New Jersey's property taxpayers; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Bernards Township Board of Education urges the Legislature to oppose S-1044/A-1926; and be it further

RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be forward to the Honorable Walter J. Kavanaugh, Senator, District #16, members of the State Senate Labor Committee and to the New Jersey School Boards Association.

On motion by Mr. Carlucci, seconded by Ms. Borushko, Item #1 was approved by all present.
